



REGISTRATION – CLASSIC,HISTORIC,VINTAGE & VETERAN VEHICLES

CLUB RULES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Members utilising club registration must be participating members in their area and take an active role in the club.
2. Registered Operators must agree they will confine their vehicle use to: (see www.transport.qld.gov.au)
 - a) Participating in rallies organised by the club
 - b) Participating in processions for which a Special Event permit has been issued under the Transport Operations Regulation 1995
 - c) Exhibiting the vehicle in displays, fetes or similar functions conducted for religious, charitable or educational purposes.
 - d) Ceremonial purposes involving immediate family members, for example weddings or school formals.(immediate family does not extend past parents,carers & their dependants. NO FEE can be charged.
 - e) Preparing for, proceeding to and returning from the above activities
 - f) Vehicles are not permitted to carry a load, except where the load is part of a display which directly relates to the authenticity of the vehicle
 - g) Road testing within a 15 km radius from where the vehicle is garaged
 - h) Travel in order to have the vehicle repaired. No distance restriction applies in these circumstances but it must be reasonable & openly justifiable.
3. If a Special Interest vehicle is being used for any other purpose, the registered operator needs to either upgrade to full registration or carry a letter of authorisation from Queensland Transport
4. Members not actively participating in the club or found to be using club registration outside the above boundaries will not obtain membership renewal and a letter will be sent to Queensland Transport.

You will be aware that a number of incidences have occurred in the south where members of the public have been injured by vehicles on club registration. It is our understanding that the clubs that arranged the club registration have been drawn into the legal process.

We do not wish to see this happen in the North, so you will understand our desire to obey the rules. We have no choice but to apply zero tolerance to illegal activities in terms of the rules.

Please don't be the one to let the club down.
